AURORA started in 2010 to identify workable strategies on how to promote and implement cervical cancer prevention in the 11 countries involved in the project (Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Latvia, Poland, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia) and ensuring coverage of hard-to-reach groups.

As a part of the AURORA activities, the project will organize a training course for healthcare professionals and advocacy leaders with the following goals:

To improve the communication skills of health care professionals and advocacy leaders to influencing institutional, community, and national policies on cervical cancer prevention.

To provide trainers with a framework to replicate the course to other trainers in their own countries according to the local environment and needs.

From the Airport of Linate

Take bus 73 departing from the piazza of the airport and exit at the end of the line, in piazza San Babila; take the Metropolitana MM1 in the direction of Fiera/Rho, exit to the stop for Cadorna Triennale, turn into piazza Cadorna, turn into via Carducci and continue to the first traffic light, crossing corso Magenta,

#### From the Airport of Malpensa

Take shuttle train "Malpensa Express" and reach the head of the line at Milano Cadorna, turn into piazza Cadorna, turn into via Carducci and continue to the first traffic light, crossing corso Magenta, Hotel Palazzo delle Stelline awaits you at number 61.
